The selection of the candidate for this Award will be made by a selection committee based on the following guidelines.

Guidelines

Eligibility:

- The award is open to all responsible librarians employed by university, college, school, public, special, and corporate libraries.
- The winner will receive the award based on their efforts and accomplishments as demonstrated in their application.
- At the time of application, the candidate must have been a BOSLA life member for five years in a row.
- > While serving on a BOSLA committee, a member is not eligible to apply for the same.

Criteria:

- The award acknowledges applicants' contributions to the profession and Association, but it is not limited to:
- Particular accomplishments or sustained excellence in acquiring, organising, interpreting, and providing access to knowledge;
- > Significant impact on the library profession and services.
- Consistently upholding the highest standards of librarianship to improve the activities and standard.
- > Contributions in books, book chapters, and conference proceedings;
- Publication of research papers in national and international journals;
- > Participation in national and international conferences for the presentation of papers.
- > Personal and professional accomplishments
- Substantial support for their libraries and strong involvement in BOSLA events
- Each year, just one Award will be given;

Selection Committee: The selection committee will be appointed by the Chairman of BOSLA. It will comprise of three members team. The selection committee will scrutinize the applications, select and make recommendation to the Chairman who will take the final decision

Award Ceremony: The selected distinguished Librarian / LIS professional will be publicly honored with a Commemorative Award at the Award ceremony which will be held during the coming BOSLA event.
